APPOINTMENT OF OFFICE-BEARERS.

Mr CRAMOND thanked the Club for electing him to be president and for the support accorded during his year of office. He proposed as his successor in the presidency Rev. George Sutherland, M.A., Portsoy. Mr John Allan, solicitor, seconded the motion, which was unanimously adopted.

Rev. Mr SUTHERLAND acknowledged the compliment, and accepted the nomination.

Mr ALEX. RAMSAY, Earllhill, proposed the re-appointment of Mr John Yeats as secretary, Mr W. Simpson as assistant secretary, and of Mr Garden M. Hossack as treasurer, which was carried with acclamation.

Rev. JAMES DAVIDSON, the Parsonage, moved that Mr Cramond's name be added to the list of vice-presidents, and that the former vice-presidents be re-appointed, viz.:—Rev. Dr Milne, King-Edward; Rev. W. S. Bruce, Banff; Rev. James Davidson, Banff; Mr Alex. Ramsay, Banff; Mr James Spence, Peterhead. The motion was agreed to.

Mr JAMES FORBES, solicitor, moved, and it was unanimously agreed to, that the following be appointed members of council for next year, viz.—Mr Andrew L. Nicol, Bailie Smith, Mr Robert Sheriffs, Rev. Æ. Chisholm, and Mr Alex. Greig.

The corresponding members and local secretaries were re-elected as follows—Rev. D. C. Boyd, Portsoy; Rev. James Sutherland, Tarriff; Rev. Alex. Bremner, Fyvie; Mr James Lawson, Huntly; Mr J. M'Donald, Buckie; and Mr A. W. Farquhar, Gamrie.

Rev. George Sutherland, president, and Mr Alex. Greig, Sandlaw, were appointed delegates to the council of the Northern Association of Literary and Scientific Societies.
