TREASURER'S REPORT.

The treasurer, Mr G. M. Hossack, Sheriff-clerk, submitted his annual financial statement for the year. It showed that the cash in hand at the date of last account was £51 16s. 3d., and that the amount of members' subscriptions was £19 2s. 6d.—making a total income of £70 18s. 9d. The cash in hand at the end of the year was £50 16s. 5d.; and the Club's outlays had been as follows:—To subscription for testimonial to Mr Wallace, Inverness, £2 2s.; to subscription to Banff Museum, £10; to *Banffshire Journal* for printing, £2 10s. 6d.; to postages, stationery, and calling meetings, £1 6s. 5d.; to year book of Societies, 6s.; rent of hall, 15s.; transactions of joint meetings and carriage, £2 12s. 5d.; paid Mr Brown for collecting subscriptions, 10s.

Mr HOSSACK stated that the arrears of subscriptions outstanding amounted to £15 10s.

On the motion of the chairman, the report, which was considered highly favourable, was adopted
